

INTERNATIONAL SPOUSES' GROUP SCHOLARSHIP 2010-2011

WHO WE ARE:

The International Spouses Group (ISG) is a special interest group to help its' members adapt to life in the United States, while being away from their homelands. Its' sister organization, the Wright Patterson Officers' Spouses' Club (WPOSC), is a private organization developed as a welfare and social forum for the spouses of military members.

The ISG will award one or more \$1,000 academic scholarship to deserving high school seniors from eligible foreign military families. The number of awards is based on the previous year's revenue from the annual ISG Fair. Applicants are responsible for ensuring their packet is completed and arrives before the March 1, 2011 deadline.

The purpose of the International Spouses' Group Scholarship program is to identify, recognize, and reward outstanding young men and women graduating from our area's secondary schools. Our program was established to aid the continued education of students who have demonstrated the highest personal and intellectual qualities through superior academic performance and who have participated in and have led extracurricular and community activities.

JUDGING PROCESS

The Scholarship Judging Committee will make the final selection. This committee is composed of an impartial panel of three professionals – ISG members and/or professional members of the community. Judges cannot be from the country that any of the applicants are from. Judges and applicant anonymity will be preserved during the selection process. Gender, race, and country of origin will not be considered during judging. The ISG chairperson, who oversees the application process, will not take part in the judging process. All decisions of the Scholarship Judging Committee will be final. Individual scores will not be discussed with the applicant or any other individual. Each applicant will be notified by mail of the results.

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INTERNATIONAL SPOUSES' GROUP SCHOLARSHIP Eligibility Guidelines 2010-2011

ALL APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Possess a valid military dependent Identification Card, and be an official dependent of a foreign military member who is full-time active duty at Wright Patterson AFB (WPAFB). The mother of the applicant, or the applicant (in the case of spouse scholarships), must be an active member of the ISG at WPAFB.
- B. Reside in the WPAFB servicing area (for these purposes, the WPAFB servicing area is to be within 150 miles of WPAFB.)
- C. Be a graduating high school senior currently attending a public, private, parochial, or home school in the WPAFB area.
- D. Have made an application to the college(s) of their choice, which includes vocational or technical schools. Will attend the college of applicant's choice as a full-time student.
- E. Perform the schoolwork required by their country of origin, if applicable.
- F. One parent or spouse must volunteer at the ISG Fair in April 2011. Should this requirement fail to be met, the recipient must forfeit their ISG scholarship.
- G. The student has not received any failing grades while in High School. The student must be academically in the top 10% of his/her graduating High School class. Also, the student must have earned a minimum score, as listed, on any of the following standardized tests -- 28 on the ACT, 1250 on the SAT, or 650 on the GED.
- H. Prior recipients of a ISG Scholarship are ineligible for a second scholarship. Applicants who have a prior criminal conviction, or is convicted at any time while receiving ISG academic scholarship are automatically disqualified.
- I. Applicant has completed and mailed the ISG scholarship application and attachments before the deadline of March 1, 2011.

The complete application must be mailed by certified mail. It is solely the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application reaches the ISG chairperson before the deadline. Please type and do not use abbreviations. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered. ___ Counselor's Data Sheet with attached copies of:

 Official transcripts from school attended in the United States

 Documentation proving a top 10% rank in graduating class.

 School copy of either the SAT or ACT scores, with a minimum score, as listed, on any of the following standardized tests -- 28 on the ACT, 1250 on the SAT, or 650 on the GED.

___ A one-page, typed personal essay of NOT MORE than 500 words, expressing and stating your aims and goals in obtaining an education.

___ 1 letter of recommendation from a teacher and/or principal (in a sealed envelope with the signature of the teacher and/or principal on the seal).

___ 1 letter of recommendation from an adult not related to the applicant (in a sealed envelope with the adult's signature on the seal).

___ 1 letter of recommendation from an employer or volunteer coordinator (in a sealed envelope with the employer or volunteer coordinator's signature on the seal).

___ Student Agreement Form signed by the applicant and the parent.

___ Photocopy of the applicant's military dependent ID card, front and back.

This scholarship award will be based primarily on performance during high school.

If I am selected as a winner, I understand that it will be my responsibility to provide the International Scholarship Chairman with the address of the bursar's office of the school I will be attending AND official proof of registration. She will then forward a check to that office along with a letter stating that the money is to be used for payment of tuition and college-sponsored room and board only.

If, for any reason, I am unable to attend school full-time, I will notify the International Scholarship Chairperson immediately. If my parent or spouse fails to volunteer at the ISG Fair in April 2011, I will notify the ISG chairperson and forfeit my ISG scholarship. If, for any reason, I have a criminal conviction at any time while receiving the ISG scholarship, I will notify the International Scholarship Chair and forfeit the ISG award. In any of these cases, the scholarship money will be used for the next year's award.

If, for any reason, I decide to transfer to another college, or decide to discontinue attendance, it is my responsibility to notify the International Scholarship Chairperson, so that any remaining money may be properly handled. I understand that in any of these cases, the money will be returned to the the International Spouses' Scholarship fund.
